She was elected chairman of the Northrop Grumman Board of Directors on August 1, 2019, and has served as CEO and president since January 1, 2019. She was elected to the company's board of directors in 2018.

Prior to becoming CEO and president, Warden served as president and chief operating officer, responsible for the operational management of the company's four sectors as well as its enterprise services organization. Her role encompassed all aspects of the company's operations, including leading engagement with the senior customer community and partners around the globe. She also led the integration of Northrop Grumman's Innovation Systems sector.

Previously, she served as corporate vice president and president of Northrop Grumman's Mission Systems and Information Systems sectors.

Warden has extensive experience in operational leadership and business development in government and commercial markets. Prior to joining Northrop Grumman in 2008, Warden held leadership roles at General Dynamics and the Veridian Corporation, she was a principal in a venture internet firm, and she spent nearly a decade with the General Electric Company working in commercial industries.

Warden earned a bachelor's degree from James Madison University and a master's degree in business administration from George Washington University. Currently, she serves as the chair of the Board of Directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of Richmond and is a member of the Catalyst Board of Directors and the James Madison University Board of Visitors.

Marillyn A. Hewson is executive chairman of Lockheed Martin Corporation. She served as Lockheed Martin's chairman, president and chief executive officer from January 2014 to June 2020 and held the positions of president and chief executive officer from January 2013 to December 2013.

Ms. Hewson joined Lockheed Martin more than 35 years ago as an industrial engineer. During her career she has held leadership positions across the corporation, including president and chief operating officer and executive vice president of Lockheed Martin's Electronic Systems business area; president of Lockheed Martin Systems Integration; executive vice president of Global Sustainment for Lockheed Martin Aeronautics: and president and general manager of Kelly Aviation Center, L.P.; senior vice president of Corporate Shared Services; vice president of Global Supply Chain Management; and vice president of Corporate Internal Audit.

Ms. Hewson currently serves on the board of directors of Johnson & Johnson, the Congressional Medal of Honor Foundation, the Board of Governors of the USO, and as chair of the Catalyst Board of Directors. She is a member of The University of Alabama's President's Cabinet and the Board of Visitors of the Culverhouse College of Business. Ms. Hewson has served on several U.S. government advisory bodies, including her current appointment to the American Workforce Policy Advisory Board.

Ms. Hewson is a member of the Business Roundtable and Business Council, a Fellow of the Royal Aeronautical Society and an Associate Fellow of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics.

In 2019, TIME magazine identified Ms. Hewson as one of the "100 Most Influential People in the World," and FORTUNE magazine ranked her No. 1 on its list of "50 Most Powerful Women in Business" for the second year in a row. In 2018, she was named the "CEO of the Year" by Chief Executive magazine, a Top 10 "Businessperson of the Year" by FORTUNE magazine, and one of the "World's 100 Most Powerful Women" by Forbes.

Cindy Baier is the President and CEO of Brookdale Senior Living, the nation's leading operator of senior living communities and one of the largest home health and hospice providers. As of year-end 2019, the \$4.1 billion company operates more than 700 senior living communities and has the ability to serve 65,000+ residents through its independent living, assisted living, memory care, and continuing care retirement communities and also serves over 20,000 patients through its home health, hospice and outpatient therapy services. The company's 50,000+ employees are taking care of America's seniors and in 2019 Fortune magazine ranked Brookdale as one of the 150 largest publicly listed employers in the country.

Ms. Baier became Brookdale's President, Chief Executive Officer and a member of the Board of Directors on February 28, 2018. As CEO she initiated and is leading the company's operational turnaround strategy. Her accomplishments can be seen over an array of areas, including people, portfolio and operations. Retention rates of the company's top community leaders are strong and a large amount of former associates returned to work for Brookdale. She helped focus the company's efforts on increasing diversity, resulting in the Board and executive leadership team approaching gender parity. Ms. Baier led Brookdale's efforts to negotiate and restructure leases with its largest three REIT partners and to unlock significant value through the sale of assets, including Brookdale's interest in the unconsolidated entry, CCRC ventures. Within the second year after introducing the "winning locally" strategy, the company outperformed the sequential industry occupancy growth and the company's Net Promoter Score® increased 20%.

Ms. Baier has served for more than a decade as a board member of public and private companies and organizations. She currently serves as a member of the board of directors of the National

Investment Center for the Seniors Housing & Care Industry (NIC) and the Nashville Health Care Council, where she serves on the Executive Committee. Effective May 2020, Ms. Baier became a member of the NYSE Board Advisory Council, which identifies and connects diverse board candidates to NYSE-listed companies seeking new directors.

Ms. Baier has been recognized by a number of professional organizations.
