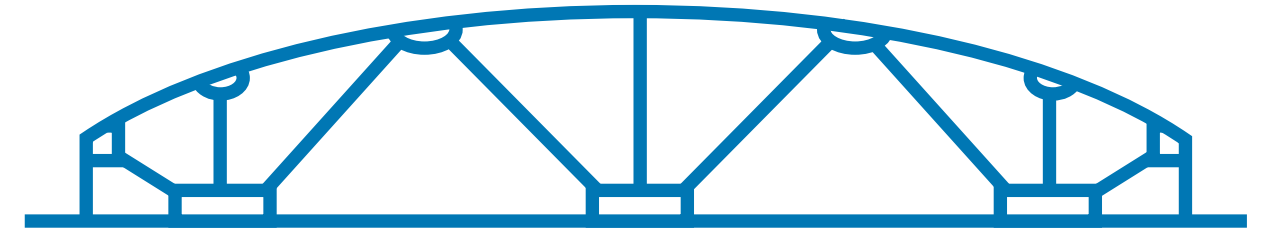
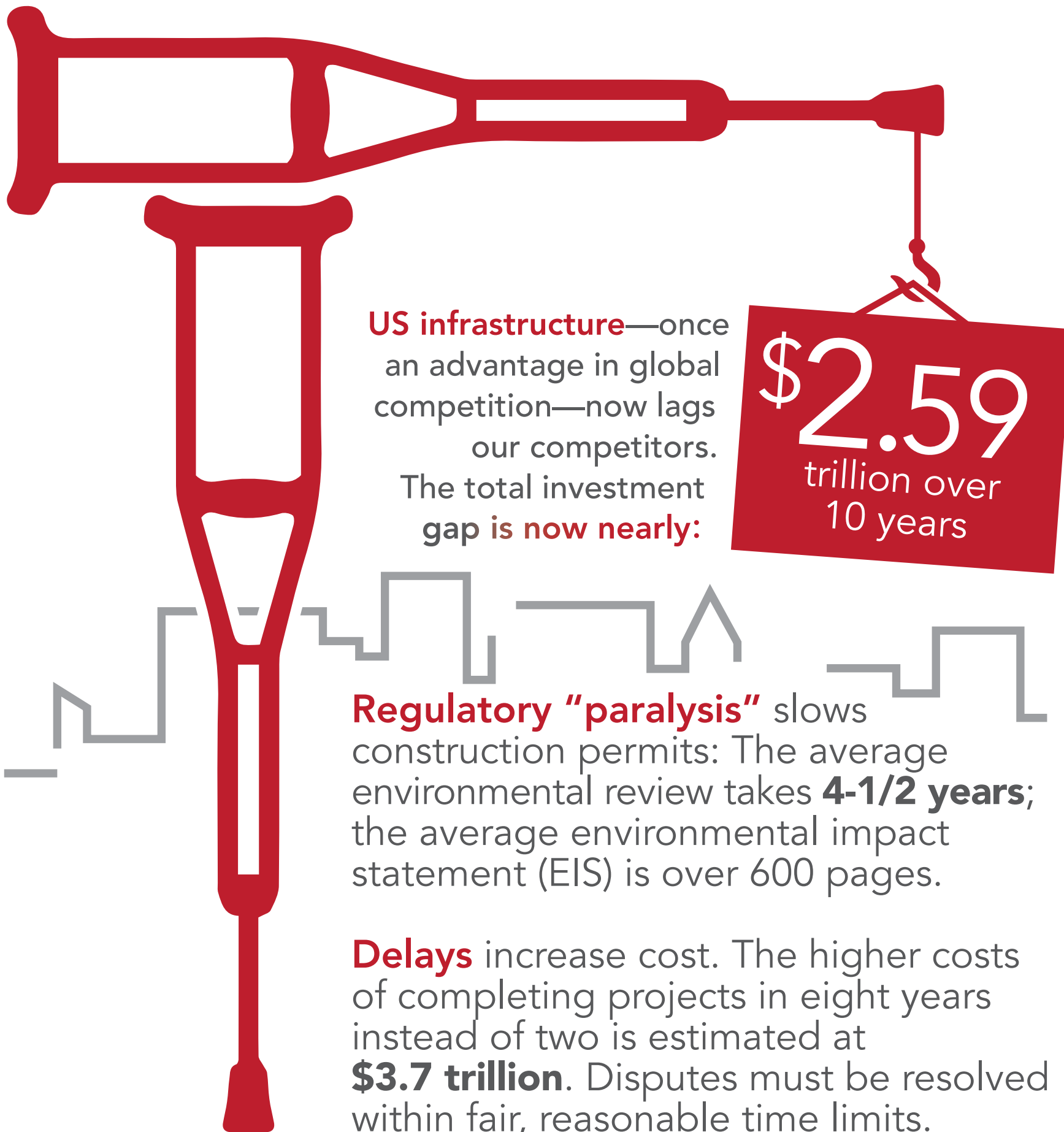

Solutions for Faster Federal Permitting

- 1 A bipartisan** Senate-confirmed three-member panel makes final decisions, demonstrating fairness and legitimacy.
- 2 A single decision** process uses a single document for the permit.
- 3 Limits on judicial review** require material objections after full participation in the permitting process, within two years, considering benefits as well as costs.
- 4 Time limits:** a final decision within two years, with the expert panel free to decide by the deadline.
- 5 Limits on paperwork:** 150 pages for environmental impact statements, 300 pages for the most complex projects—the original intent of the law.

Why it matters: Dollars should be spent on asphalt, concrete, steel and labor, not transactions costs.
