



# **EU Taxonomy**

### Environmental objectives that the Taxonomy aims to cover





### The EU Taxonomy defines activities as "Environmentally Sustainable" if

Complies with Substantially Do no significant Meets minimum contribute to at harm to any of the safeguards (i.e., **Technical** least one of the six other five does not have Screening Criteria environmental environmental any negative social impacts) objectives objectives




# Taxonomy disclosure timelines are different for different entities, creating possible confusion







# BASF has set-up an internal project to fulfill taxonomy reporting obligations





## Our challenge: screening of our entire product and investment portfolio in <6 months and delivering new KPIs for annual report 2021

46,000 products

>10,000 investment projects

~250 sites

~700 plants



# Our upcoming challenge: how to ensure that taxonomy aligned investment projects generate taxonomy aligned sales?

Example: new plant, start-up in 2027 and running time > 10 years


