

Benchmarking Impact Has Long Eluded the Nonprofit Sector

"There is incredible 'silver bulletism' seeking that 'one special number' that will tell us if we are succeeding or failing. This is driven by bureaucratic fantasy, not reality." - Susan Stout, former Manager of the World Bank's Results Secretariat
